Show Rules:

The show will be governed by the rules for conduct of shows established by ECAHO.

Entry Conditions and Qualifications:

Open to Arabian horses registered in Emirates Arabian Horse Society by the closing date of entries.

The owner must be a citizen of the United Arab Emirates.

Need to obtain one of the qualifications from following ECAHO affiliated Shows in UAE since 01/10/2021 till entry closing date:

SHOWS	QUALIFICATION
International A, B and C ShowsNational Championships (N)	Horse has to be placed 1 st to 7 th in qualifying class
C National ShowsB National ShowsSpecific Origin Shows	Horse has to be placed 1st to 3rd in a qualifying class

Qualification is not required for the horses not participated in any UAE shows from 01/10/2021. Yearlings do not need to qualify. Maximum of 7 horses per owner.

Entry restrictions:

Has not been a champion (Gold, Silver, Bronze) in:

- a) Any ECAHO Title Shows, A International Shows, B International Shows or equivalent shows since 01/10/2021.
- b) UAE National Championship from 01/10/2021.

Except a yearling becomes a junior or a junior becomes a senior.

Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified.

Medication Control:

All entered horses will be subject to doping test according to ECAHO rules at the discretion of the DC.

Judging system:

Horses will be judged by judges with 5 Topics system with half points

Marks from 1 to 20 for type

Marks from 1 to 20 for head & neck

Marks from 1 to 20 for body

Marks from 1 to 20 for legs

Marks from 1 to 20 for movement

The highest mark as well as the lowest mark of each topic will be eliminated.

- Emirates Arabian Horse Society reserves the right to amend the participation conditions.
- The organizing committee reserves the right to limit the total number of entries per show.
- The approved copy is English.
