



Emirates Arabian Horse Breeders Championship (Private Studs and Owners) (March 2023)

ECAHO B National

Show Rules:

The show will be governed by the rules for conduct of shows established by ECAHO.

Entry Conditions and Qualifications:

- Arabian horses registered with Emirates Arabian Horse Society by the closing date of entries.
- The owner must be a citizen of the United Arab Emirates and the breeder of the horse.

Entry restrictions:

- Gold, Silver and Bronze champion medal winners at any ECAHO Title Shows or A International Shows or B International Shows or Equivalent Shows held since 01/10/2020 are not allowed to participate, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior or from junior to a senior category.
- Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified.
- Maximum of 7 horses per owner.

Fees:

Entry Fees **2,100 Dirhams (VAT Included)**

If the ownership changes after entry closing date and the new owner wants to participate, 4,200 Dirhams will be charged as Entry Fees.

Medication Control:

All entered horses will be subject to doping test according to ECAHO rules at the discretion of the DC.

Judging system:

Horses will be Judged by Judges with 5 Topics system (**head & neck split**) with half points

Marks from 1 to 20 for type

Marks from 1 to 20 for **head** +Marks from 1 to 20 for **neck**

Marks from 1 to 20 for body

Marks from 1 to 20 for legs

Marks from 1 to 20 for movement

The highest mark as well as the lowest mark of each topic will be eliminated.
