



Abu Dhabi International Arabian Horse Championship

ECAHO 'Title'

Show Rules:

The show will be governed by the rules for conduct of shows established by ECAHO.

Entry Conditions and Qualifications:

All Arabian horses registered in WAHO approved studbook by closing date of entries.

All participating horses should have qualified at an ECAHO affiliated shows in one of the following ways from 01/01/2022:

- 1st to 5th place at World Championship or Title Shows
- 1st to 3rd place at A International Shows or B International Shows
- 1st to 3rd place at National Championships
- 1st to 2nd place at B National Shows, C National Shows, C International Shows, European Shows or Specific Origin Shows

Horses registered in countries which are not Members of ECAHO must either qualify in an ECAHO affiliated show or may qualify at other shows accepted by the EAHSC, such as:

- a title of Champion or Reserve Champion or "TOP FIVE" at the US Nationals
- a title of Champion or Reserve Champion or a 1st place at the US Scottsdale Competition
- a title of Champion or Reserve Champion in US "Regional" competitions
- a title of Champion or Reserve Champion or 1st to 3rd place in an official National Championship show
- 1st to 3rd place at the US World Cup show
- a title of Champion of Reserve champion or 1st to 3rd place in an Egyptian Event US

Maximum of 7 horses per owner

Medication Control:

The medication testing of all Champion Gold Medal winners is compulsory. Any horse may be tested at the discretion of the DC. All medication testing will be conducted according to ECAHO Rules for Medication Control

Judging system:

Horses will be judged by judges with 5 Topics system with half points

Marks from 1 to 20 for type

Marks from 1 to 20 for head & neck

Marks from 1 to 20 for body

Marks from 1 to 20 for legs

Marks from 1 to 20 for movement

The highest mark as well as the lowest mark of each topic will be eliminated.

- The organizing committee reserves the right to limit the total number of entries per show.
