Show Rules:

The show will be governed by the rules for conduct of shows established by ECAHO.

Entry Conditions and Qualifications:

Open to horses registered in Emirates Arabian Horse Society by the closing date of entries.

- Horse has to be placed 1st to 10th in qualifying classes of ECAHO affiliated or equivalent shows in UAE from 01/10/2020 till entry closing date.
- Qualification is not required for the horses not participated in any UAE shows from 01/10/2020. Yearlings do not need to qualify.
- Maximum of 3 horses per owner

Entry restrictions:

- Champion medal winners (Gold, Silver and Bronze) in ECAHO affiliated or equivalent shows from 01/10/2020 are not allowed to take part, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior or from junior to a senior category.
- Anybody entering an overqualified horse will be liable to a fine of €600 and the horse will be disqualified.

Fees:

Entry Fees **2,100 AED (VAT Included)**

- If the ownership changes after entry closing date and the new owner wants to participate, 4,200 AED will be charged as Entry Fees.
- If the payment is not made within the period, the horse will be withdrawn from the championship automatically

Medication Control:

All entered horses will be subject to doping test according to ECAHO rules at the discretion of the DC.

Judging system:

Horses will be judged by judges with 5 Topics system with half points

Marks from 1 to 20 for type

Marks from 1 to 20 for head & neck

Marks from 1 to 20 for body

Marks from 1 to 20 for legs

Marks from 1 to 20 for movement

The highest mark as well as the lowest mark of each topic will be eliminated.

- The organizing committee reserves the right to limit the total number of entries and accept any horse in the show.
