



Al Shiraa' International Arabian Horse Championship (February 2023)

ECAHO 'B' International

Show Rules:

The show will be governed by the rules for conduct of shows established by ECAHO.

Entry Conditions and Qualifications:

All Arabian horses registered in WAHO approved studbook by closing date of entries.

All horses should have qualified at an ECAHO affiliated shows in one of the following ways from 01/01/2021:

- 1st to 5th place in Title Shows (Or equivalent shows) or A International Shows or B International Shows.
- 1st to 3rd place in C International Shows or National Championships (N) or B National Shows or C National Shows or Specific Origin Shows.
- Maximum of 7 horses per owner.

Entry restrictions:

Gold and Silver champion medal winners in Title Shows (Or equivalent shows) or A International Shows held since 01/01/2021 are not allowed to take part, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior or from junior to a senior category.

Gold champion medal winners in two B International Shows in the same year are not allowed to take part for the rest of that calendar year.

Fees:

Entry Fees **3,150 Dirhams (VAT Included).**

If the ownership changes after entry closing date and the new owner wants to participate, 4,200 Dirhams will be charged as Entry Fees.

Medication Control:

All entered horses will be subject to doping test according to ECAHO rules at the discretion of the DC.

Judging system:

Horses will be Judged by Judges with 5 Topics system (**head & neck split**) with half points

Marks from 1 to 20 for type

Marks from 1 to 20 for **head** +Marks from 1 to 20 for **neck**

Marks from 1 to 20 for body

Marks from 1 to 20 for legs

Marks from 1 to 20 for movement

The highest mark as well as the lowest mark of each topic will be eliminated.
